A.1 Council Process Committee Agenda - January 11, 2021

Recommendation: That the Council Process Committee approve the agenda and receive the agenda items of the January 11, 2021 meeting.

The following motion was referred at the November 30, 2020 Council Process Committee meeting:

B. ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION

B.1 Murrayville and Brookwood Water Quality Improvements Report 20-125 File ENG 5330-27-82

Recommendation: K. Larsen provided an update on the water quality complaints in Murrayville and Brookwood. He noted that five wells were shut down in November 2019 Murrayville for esthetic reasons. After a report with three options was received from an outside consultant, the option of oxidation and filtration is the preferred option by staff. A temporary Water Treatment Plant in a storage container can be brought on site, and moved as needed. Three water treatment plants at the cost of \$6.4million is recommended by staff.

Alternative recommendations, in order of preference, include:

1. Phase construction over three years;
2. Abandon local water sources and purchase Metro Vancouver water; or
3. Utilize the groundwater without any treatments.

That the Council Process Committee recommends that Council direct staff to include funding in the amount of \$6,000,000 in the 2021 Water Utility budget for Council's consideration of approval to enable construction of the three (3) localized water treatment plants for the Murrayville and Brookwood areas, and authorize staff to proceed with the necessary detailed design work, utilizing funding currently available in the Water Utility account.
