## **2. Additional Information**

### **Desired Resolution:**

That the Notice of Motions be approved in its entirety by the Langley Township Council, and that the Langley Seniors Community Action Table be included as a representative seniors' stakeholder group in the community engagement process.

### **Activities to date relative to the matter:**

With affordable housing for seniors has been identified as a priority for education, awareness and action by the LSCAT, given the key role housing plays as a key element of an Age-Friendly Community, and a key health determinant, enabling seniors to age in place and access community-based health care. In 2016, as a founding member of Triple A Senior Housing, LSCAT published findings of a 2015 Senior Housing Survey and 2015 Senior Housing Summit which Triple A Senior Housing had hosted; in 2017 LSCAT partnered with Triple A Housing and the Langley Senior Resources Society to host a "Senior Housing and Homelessness" Panel Discussion with Minister Coleman (Minister of Housing) and Mayor Jack Froese of the Township of Langley and Mayor Ted Schaffer of the City of Langley with 120 seniors in attendance. Our current Housing Committee has developed plans which encompass federal, provincial and community strategies and tactics, focused on the delivery of affordable, accessible, appropriate housing for seniors.
