HIGHWAY CLOSING AND DEDICATION REMOVAL (LYNTERRA) BYLAW 2017 NO. 5322

EXPLANATORY NOTE

Bylaw 2017 No. 5322 authorizes the closure and highway dedication removal from a portion of 219A Street and 220 Street at 44A Avenue.

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HIGHWAY CLOSING AND DEDICATION REMOVAL (LYNTERRA) BYLAW 2017 NO. 5322

WHEREAS pursuant to subsection 40(1)(a) of the *Community Charter*, S.B.C. 2003, c. 26, the Council may, by bylaw, close all or part of a highway that is vested in the municipality to all or some types of traffic;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to section 40(2) of the *Community Charter*, S.B.C. 2003, c. 26, the Council may, by bylaw, remove the dedication of a highway that has been closed by a bylaw under subsection 40(1)(a);

NOW THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Langley, in Open Meeting Assembled, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "Highway Closing and Dedication Removal (Lynterra) Bylaw 2017 No. 5322."
- Those portions of road lying in Section 31 Township 10 NWD shown outlined in heavy black line on the reference plan attached hereto as Schedule "A", prepared by Matthew C. Onderwater, BCLS, completed on the 30 day of March, 2017, and more particularly described as:
 - all that portion of Parcel A containing 653.2 square meters and all that portion of Parcel B containing 746.2 square meters, both dedicated on Plan 1103 (the "Closed Road");

shall be closed to traffic.

3. The dedication as highway shall be removed from the Closed Road.

The Township Clerk is hereby authorized to sign the plan(s) of survey and any such other instrument(s) as may be required to carry into effect the closure and dedication removal described in this bylaw.
