Bylaw 2018 No. 5368 amends the Fees and Charges Bylaw 2007 No. 4616, and its amendments, to add new fees or other adjustments to the following Schedules, to address new or enhanced municipal services, and continuing the consolidation of the Township of Langley Fees and Charges Bylaw:

- Schedule 1: RECREATION, CULTURE, and PARKS
- Schedule 2: CEMETERIES
- Schedule 3: ANIMAL CONTROL
- Schedule 5: MISCELLANEOUS CORPORATE
- Schedule 6: POLICE
- Schedule 7: FIRE
- Schedule 8: TRANSPORTATION
- Schedule 10: FILMING
- Schedule 11: WATERWORKS
- Schedule 12: SEWER
- Schedule 13: STORMWATER

FEES AND CHARGES BYLAW 2007 NO. 4616

AMENDMENT BYLAW 2018 NO. 5368

WHEREAS pursuant to section 194 of the *Community Charter*, Council may, by bylaw, impose a fee payable in respect of all or part of a fee or service of the municipality, the use of municipal property, or the exercise of authority to regulate, prohibit or impose requirements;

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Council deems it necessary and desirable to exercise the authority provided by the *Community Charter* to cover costs of providing various fees, services and information;

NOW THEREFORE, the Township of Langley Council, in Open Meeting Assembled, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "Fees and Charges Bylaw 2007 No. 4616 Amendment Bylaw 2018 No. 5368".
2. If a portion of this bylaw is held invalid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, the invalid portion must be severed and the remainder of this bylaw is deemed to have been adopted without the severed section, subsection, paragraph, subparagraph, clause or phrase.
3. The Township hereby imposes fees and charges for the provision of services and information as specified in Schedules "1", "2", "3", "5", "6", "7", "8", "10", "11", "12", and "13", attached to and forming part of this bylaw. Schedules "4", and "9" remain unchanged.
4. The following fees and charges are hereby imposed to align with the new Fees and Charges Bylaw 2018 No. 5368
 - a) Recreation, Parks & Culture – Schedule 1
 - b) Cemeteries – Schedule 2
 - c) Miscellaneous Corporate – Schedule 5
 - d) Fire – Schedule 7
 - e) Solid Waste – Schedule 9
 - f) Waterworks – Schedule 11
 - g) Sanitary Sewer – Schedule 12
 - h) Stormwater – Schedule 13
5. Federal and Provincial sales taxes will be added when applicable.
6. Wherever this Bylaw sets out fees and charges with respect to other Township bylaws and such other bylaws contain similar fees and charges, this Bylaw is deemed to prevail.

 - ii. adding after the words, ‘include a security deposit’, the words ‘, in an amount determined by the Engineer,’; and
 - iii. replacing the word ‘charge’ with the word ‘fee’ after the words ‘a non-refundable application’
 - g) In Section 608, in the first paragraph, replacing the word ‘application’ with the word ‘Permit’.
 - h) In Section 608 (2) & (3), deleting the word ‘hereafter’ from the end of each clause.
 - i) In Section 608 (4) b. & e., replacing the words “‘Township of Langley Subdivision and Development Control Bylaw 1994 No. 3335”” with the words ‘Township of Langley Subdivision and Development Servicing Bylaw 2011 No. 4861, as amended or replaced from time to time’.
 - j) In Section 611, after the words ‘payment of the’ deleting the word ‘application’ and replacing it with the word ‘Permit’.
 - k) In Section 611 and Section 612, replacing the words ‘Schedule B”’ with the words ‘the Fees and Charges Bylaw’.

- l) In Section 612, deleting the words 'of this Bylaw' at the end of the clause.
- m) In Section 615 (1), deleting the words 'application fee and the' and deleting the words 'of this Bylaw'.

- o) In Section 702, replacing the words 'the procedure in Schedule D of this Bylaw' with the words 'Bylaw Notice Enforcement Bylaw 2008 No. 4703, as amended or replaced from time to time'.
- p) In Section 704, adding to the end of the sentence the words ', as amended or replaced from time to time'.
- q) In Section 706, replacing the words 'Schedule E herein' with the words 'the Fees and Charges Bylaw'.

- s) Deleting Schedule B in its entirety.
- t) Deleting Schedule D in its entirety.
