

**THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LANGLEY  
HIGHWAY CLOSING AND DEDICATION REMOVAL (MCCALL)  
BYLAW 2018 NO. 5354**

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

Bylaw 2018 No. 5354 authorizes the closure and highway dedication removal from a portion of lane at 198A Street and 38B Avenue.

**BYLAW 2018 NO. 5354**

WHEREAS pursuant to subsection 40(1)(a) of the *Community Charter*, S.B.C. 2003, c. 26, the Council may, by bylaw, close all or part of a highway that is vested in the municipality to all or some types of traffic;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to section 40(2) of the *Community Charter*, S.B.C. 2003, c. 26, the Council may, by bylaw, remove the dedication of a highway that has been closed by a bylaw under subsection 40(1)(a);

NOW THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Langley, in Open Meeting Assembled, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "Highway Closing and Dedication Removal (McCall) Bylaw 2018 No. 5354."
2. That portion of road (walkway) lying in Section 27 Township 7 NWD shown outlined in heavy black line on reference plan EPP84657 attached hereto as Schedule "A", prepared by Finny Philip, BCLS, completed on the 31st day of May, 2018, and more particularly described as:

that portion shown as Lot A on Schedule "A" containing 98.2 square meters and having been dedicated road (walkway) on Plan 48732;

shall be closed to traffic (hereinafter "Parcel A").

3. The dedication as highway shall be removed from Parcel A.
4. The Township Clerk is hereby authorized to sign the plan(s) of survey and any such other instrument(s) as may be required to carry into effect the closure and dedication removal described in this bylaw.
