**SUBJECT**: LANGLEY FEES AND CHARGES BYLAW AMENDMENT

#### **RECOMMENDATION(S):**

**That** Council give first, second and third reading to the Langley Fees and Charges Bylaw 2007 No. 4616 Amendment Bylaw 2019 No. 5469.

#### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:**

Section 194 (1) of the *Community Charter* makes provision for Council to adopt bylaws approving various fees and charges that can be imposed with respect to services being provided. The proposed Township's Fees & Charges Bylaw No. 4616 will include fourteen fees and charges categories under separate schedules as follows:

- Schedule 1: RECREATION, CULTURE, and PARKS
- Schedule 2: CEMETERIES
- Schedule 3: ANIMAL CONTROL
- Schedule 4: FINANCE
- Schedule 5: MISCELLANEOUS CORPORATE
- Schedule 6: POLICE
- Schedule 7: FIRE
- Schedule 8: TRANSPORTATION
- Schedule 9: SOLID WASTE
- Schedule 10: FILMING
- Schedule 11: WATERWORKS
- Schedule 12: SEWER
- Schedule 13: STORMWATER
- Schedule 14: DEVELOPMENT APPLICATION FEES

On an annual basis, amendments to fees and charges are proposed to better align Township revenue with service budgets. Such amendments are outlined in this report. Schedules with no changes are referenced but not included. Updating fees and charges on a regular basis is consistent with the Township's User Pay policy and its economic sustainability goals.

LANGLEY FEES AND CHARGES BYLAW AMENDMENT Page 2 . . .

#### **PURPOSE:**

The purpose of this report is to bring forward for first, second, and third readings, Langley Fees and Charges Bylaw 2007 No. 4616 Amendment Bylaw 2019 No. 5469 highlighting additions, repealed fees and fee changes.

#### **BACKGROUND/HISTORY:**

On an annual basis, the Township undertakes a review of existing fees and charges to determine whether any price level adjustments and/or new fees and charges are necessary to existing schedules to ensure sufficient cost recovery of programs and services and to better align Township revenue with service budgets.

Specifically excluded from this bylaw are fees and charges included in other comprehensive regulatory bylaws (i.e. Soils, and Business Licenses) and user fees pursuant to Water, Sewer and Solid Waste.

#### **DISCUSSION/ANALYSIS:**

This report recommends that Council approve additions, repealed fees and changes to existing fees as outlined in the sections that follow.

#### Schedule 1: RECREATION, CULTURE, AND PARKS

Recreation, Culture, and Parks have undertaken a review of their current fees and charges, including a comparison with other municipalities.

#### General Fee Increase

This bylaw amendment reflects increases the division has experienced in the past year with respect to cost escalations for staffing, utilities, materials and supplies. It is recommended that a 3-4% average increase be applied to pool, fitness and arena admissions except where noted separately within this report. A 3% increase has been applied to facility rentals.

#### Other Proposed Changes to Fees and Charges - Recreation

Aldergrove Credit Union Community Centre (ACUCC) and Otter Co-Op Outdoor Experience (OCOE)

#### **Summary:**

Since opening in the summer of 2018 Aldergrove Credit Union Community Centre (ACUCC) has positioned itself as a unique asset within the Township of Langley (TOL). In particular, the Otter Co-op Outdoor Experience was an enormous success with over 100,000 visitors in the first 2 months of operation. As indicated in 2018, the costs to operate the waterpark in particular are significant, and based on the initial operating season it has been shown that the budget model needs to be updated to properly account for staffing and operating costs. In order to address these higher than anticipated costs, and remain within budget, the options are:

- Cut service levels
- Increase subsidy base funding
- Increase fees and charges

Staff are recommending that Mayor and Council consider an alternate fees and charges model for the ACUCC Otter Co-op Outdoor Experience during waterpark season to reflect that it is a more costly asset to operate than a traditional recreation or community centre. Three pricing options have been given for consideration and the recommendation is to increase fees by 50% compared to existing rates.

ACUCC has not yet operated for a full year, and once it has and processes are reviewed, additional adjustments to either fees or base subsidy may be necessary in 2020.

#### **Waterpark Fee Change Rationale:**

- Cost of staff: As was learned in the first year of operation, to open the waterpark and provide an adequate level of customer service, certain standards of staffing must be maintained.
  - During a typical waterpark session (3 hour block), there are between 17-19 Lifeguard staff, 12-14 Host staff, 2-4 Clerical staff as well as multiple other maintenance and supervisory staff.
  - Just in Lifeguard and Host staff costs, the total is approximately \$900 per hour to be able to adequately staff the waterpark facility.
- Demand for use: The volume of guests in 2018 was high, with many of the waterpark sessions selling out at 1000 per session. Besides the great location and it being a new facility, staff have attributed this high demand to a very inexpensive cost for admissions. Based on comparative value versus other similar waterparks, staff believe there is room to make the admission prices higher, but still offer good value for guests.
- Comparative Value: 2018 admissions were very inexpensive at ACUCC compared to local similar waterparks.
  - 3 sessions at ACUCC for comparison to a daily rate
    - Child = \$2.95 x 3 sessions = \$8.85/day (including tax)
    - Youth = \$3.80 x 3 sessions = \$11.40/day (including tax)
    - Adult = \$6.00 x 3 sessions = \$18.00/day (including tax)
  - Versus
    - Cultus Lake Waterpark = \$24/day (under 48") and \$34 (48" above) (+tax)
    - Big Splash Waterpark = \$28/day all ages (+tax)
    - Bridal Falls Waterslides = \$ 27/day all ages (+tax)

#### **Waterpark Comparisons and Options:**

Fee change options were considered in comparison to competitors and include various scenarios:

- Height Based Admission: Many waterparks reviewed charge based on height and not age. The challenge with going based on height is the limited number of attractions at OCOE for taller heights. The popular Canyon Creek (lazy river) and Breaker Bay (tidal pool) do not have height restrictions, and are available for all. Only the Roller Soakers and Big Top features have height restrictions.
- All Day Admission: Most waterparks reviewed provide only an all day pass and many also provide an end of day (Twilight) option. The challenge with offering an all day pass is the capacity of ACUCC waterpark is limited. Taking away the multiple sessions limits how many people have access in a day (i.e. 1000 vs 3000)
- All Season Pass-Only two waterpark facilities found across Canada offers a Seasons Pass (both in Ontario); a consideration, but complicated based on the multiple age rates.

- Municipal Models: Not many municipal models exist, and where they do, they charge significantly more than TOL does. (i.e. Windsor, ON \$23.75 for 42"+ all day)
- Resident Only Times: This was done in 2018 on Sunday evenings at ACUCC, with limited success. The average swim for Sunday night resident swims was 425, which meant the waterpark was not near capacity.
- Resident Only Rates: This is a consideration to keep costs low to TOL residents and still
  provide revenue through non-TOL resident rate increases. This does add bit of a service
  barrier as it adds more administrative time to process the admission for each visitor.

#### Otter Co-op Outdoor Experience Other Considerations

- ACUCC is also an operating Recreation Centre whose pools service the general public and swim club.
  - Aldergrove Sea Monkeys Swim Club: The Aldergrove Sea Monkeys (ASM) have requested 6 lanes use of the main lap pool (complete pool) Mon-Fri 6-8 pm from May-July. Staff are working with the club to figure out optimal times.
  - TOL Aquatic Programming: In 2018, limited programming was available during the waterpark season, maintaining the 3 sessions with a break in the late afternoon/evening allows lessons to be introduced in 2019.
- Family Rates: Consideration has been given to move from a flat family rate to a per person family rate. Many local municipalities have done this and the range is \$3.00 and \$4.50 per person in a family. This allows for a single parent with a child to benefit from a family rate, and it also allows for a continued discount for a larger family. This needs to be considered overall as part of the larger TOL fees and charges structure.

#### **Waterpark Fees and Charges Recommendations:**

Option 1: Maintain 3 sessions per day and increase fees based on current fees **+25%.** For Example:

- Opportunity to consider Seasons Pass

#### Other Notes

#### Consultation on Proposed Changes to Fees and Charges

Staff has consulted with the Langley Outdoor Sports Advisory Group, Arena/Dry Floor arena users, the Museum Advisory Group, the Pool Advisory Group and the Recreation, Culture, and Parks, Advisory Committee as part of this review process.

#### Financial Assistance (Policy 06-015)

The Township of Langley offers financial assistance to qualifying residents who would like to participate in recreational activities but find it difficult to do so because of financial limitations. Because of this Council policy, staff is able to refer identified customers to the Financial Assistance program where they are able to receive fair and equitable access to services.

The Township of Langley provides designated weekly Loonie/Toonie sessions at both W.C. Blair Recreation Centre and Walnut Grove Community Centre for all families or individuals to access the facilities at a reduced rate. Staff also provides a number of free family focused special events each year throughout the Township (i.e. Langley Walk, Arbour Day, and Canada Day).

#### Proposed Implementation of Fees and Charges

All Recreation, Culture, and Parks fees and charges increases, except those noted separately, will be deferred until September 1, 2019 giving users and user groups time to prepare for these increases. OCOE waterpark increases will be implemented for the 2019 waterpark season.

#### Other Proposed Changes to Fees and Charges - Parks

#### McLeod Athletic Park

The SW Lighted Baseball Diamond West Complex was upgraded to include a synthetic turf infield. As a result, a new rate class titled MAP Synthetic Turf Diamond has been created to outline Prime and Non-Prime hourly rates for commercial, private, non-profit adult and non-profit youth users ranging from \$9.23 per hour to \$61.30 per hour.

#### **General Park Fees**

- Council adopted Public Spaces Regulation Bylaw 2018 No. 5298 on September 17, 2018, along with associated policy 06-305 Park Permits on July 23, 2018. Staff have introduced a Park Permit process to facilitate exempted activities as outlined in the bylaw. An associated Park Permit application fee of \$50 is proposed to offset administrative costs associated with review and permit issuance.
- 2. The Beverage Garden Permit Fee has been removed as it is now governed by the Public Spaces Regulation Bylaw and associated processes.
- 3. To formalize existing processes undertaken with park bookings, the following items are proposed for inclusion:
  - the McLeod Athletic Park Oval Score Board at \$5.50 per hour
  - the McLeod Athletic Park Oval Audio Systems at \$7.50 per hour
  - sports field and sports box lighting at \$2 per hour
  - bleacher moves, 2 sets or fewer \$245.24
  - bleacher moves, 3 sets or more \$441.44
  - soccer goal set up per occurrence \$250

#### **Schedule 2: CEMETERIES**

#### General Fee Increase

This bylaw amendment reflects increases, experienced in the past year, with respect to cost escalations for staffing, utilities, materials, and supplies. It is recommended that a 3.0% average increase (3.0% in 2018) be applied to all Cemetery fees and charges.

In addition, and based on a review of Metro Vancouver municipal cemeteries, the following increases are required and is still in line with regional fees:

- 1. Interment resident adult size to \$3000
- 2. Interment non-resident adult size to \$6000
- 3. Interment resident cremation plot to \$1300
- 4. Interment non-resident cremation plot to \$2600
- 5. Interment resident veteran to \$1500
- 6. Interment non-resident veteran \$3000
- 7. Interment resident veteran cremation plot \$650
- 8. Interment non-resident veteran cremation plot \$1300
- 9. Interment resident natural/hybrid to \$3000
- 10. Interment non-resident natural/hybrid to \$6000

For services related to 'the opening and closing of lots for interment, cremated remains, add to existing site' an increase to the care fund to \$750 is proposed, resulting in a total cost for this service of \$1,353.

For services related to 'the opening and closing of lots for exhumation/disinterment, cremated remains' the fee is reduced to \$577.

#### Fort Langley Cemetery

Interment Premium Lots in the newly developed western portion of Fort Langley cemetery are proposed as follows:

- 1. Adult Premium Lot Interment resident casket in place upright marker adult size \$6000
- 2. Adult Premium Lot Interment non-resident casket in place upright marker adult size \$12.000
- 3. Cremation Premium Lot Interment resident upright marker cremation plot \$2,600
- 4. Cremation Premium Lot Interment non-resident upright marker cremation plot \$5,200

#### **Schedule 3: ANIMAL CONTROL**

#### Public Spaces Waste Management (Dog License)

At the Regular Afternoon Council Meeting of March 5, 2018, Council directed staff to update the parks rental and dog license rates in the Fees and Charges Bylaw, to offset the increased operating costs required to collect separated garbage, recycling and organics, and process and dispose of dog waste generated in public spaces. As indicated in Report 18-25 Public Spaces Waste Management Program Cost Offset Proposal, staff recommend an incremental increase, implemented over 4 years, to offset a portion of the costs of this program. During this second year of implementation, all dog license fees are proposed to increase \$1.20, which includes \$0.93 for waste management and \$0.24 for the Langley Animal Protection Society's commission, to be implemented in November 2019 during the annual dog license levy process. Incremental increases in subsequent years will be presented to Council for consideration through the annual Fees and Charges amendment bylaw update.

#### Highway Use

New Highway Use categories for Public Banner and Private Use of Public Sidewalks applications and permit fees have been introduced at a cost of \$100 each.

#### Municipal Access Agreement Plan Approval Fee

In order to facilitate telecommunication company connection of fibre optic networks to Township infrastructure, and microcell or minicell/wifi installations on Township assets, a new Municipal Access Agreement process has been implemented. The plan approval fee is proposed at \$500 for each pole type installation, or \$500 for each linear installation up to 250 metres, with additional costs of \$50 for each additional 100m of fibre optic cable.

#### Over Street Banner Fee

For banner installation over streets, currently applicable to the downtown cores of Aldergrove and Fort Langley, two new fees are proposed; an application fee of \$50, and a \$250 fee to offset the cost of installing and removing the banners, per occurrence. These charges are in addition to the cost of the Highway Use Permit requirement previously proposed in the Schedule 8.

**Schedule 11: WATERWORKS** 

Residents and businesses utilizing the Aldergrove Water Stand Pipe have historically been provided a fob for accessing the Aldergrove Aqualoader Terminal at no cost. A new replacement fee for instances where the original fob was lost was implemented in 2017. As a result of requests for multiple fobs on single accounts, staff propose that all fobs be charged out at \$20, regardless of whether they are new or replacement.

#### Schedule 12: SEWER

#### Housekeeping

A text amendment is required to clarify that a security deposit is required for both connection and disconnection to the sanitary sewer system, and to align with the adoption of Langley Sewerworks Regulation Bylaw 2018 No. 5367 related to the requirement for an application to reuse an existing service in conjunction with a building permit.
