Highlight the Western Toad population in Brookwood. Juvenile migration occurs during July, where thousands of toadlets are expected to move en masse from their breeding wetlands (between 16 Ave - 20 Ave, and 196 St - 200 St) to surrounding terrestrial habitats. Western Toads are a species at risk and this is the only known population in South Langley. We would like to request a temporary road closure of 20 Ave and 196 St for 2 weeks during peak migration (likely mid-July) to minimize impact of road mortality.
