This will be the third annual Ceremony to be held in Murrayville and our committee is working diligently to address the issues that develop each year. With the unexpected but much appreciated support and attendance this event has had in just two years the committee is committed to making and keeping this a simple but meaningful Ceremony. . . . and SAFE! Who would have expected 300 people to attend the first year and over 700 the second!! This year we are hoping to have a better traffic control plan in place. I have attached a draft copy of the site plan for this year. We are making a slight change in staging area around the cenotaph. Our scouts and guides deserve better opportunity to participate. There will also be a safer procession gathering area.

The procession gathers at the south end of the cemetery and walks to the Cenotaph area leaving at 10:30 - with the program starting at 10:40. Constable Kirby Adams will again be in charge of the procession.. . and there will be a "live" piper! There will be seating for dignitaries. We would appreciate knowing before the event who will be laying the wreath.

Last year Township Council contributed to the cost of the Fraser Blues Formation Team Fly-past of all three ToL Ceremonies. If you could do that again it would be much appreciated.
