# THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LANGLEY HIGHWAY CLOSING AND DEDICATION REMOVAL (TOWNSHIP – FORT BLOCK LANE) BYLAW 2020 NO. 5634

#### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

Bylaw 2020 No. 5634 authorizes the closure and highway dedication removal from a portion of lane between Royal Street and King Street at Mavis Avenue.

## HIGHWAY CLOSING AND DEDICATION REMOVAL (TOWNSHIP – FORT BLOCK LANE) BYLAW 2020 NO. 5634

WHEREAS pursuant to subsection 40(1)(a) of the *Community Charter*, S.B.C. 2003, c. 26, the Council may, by bylaw, close all or part of a highway that is vested in the municipality to all or some types of traffic;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to section 40(2) of the *Community Charter*, S.B.C. 2003, c. 26, the Council may, by bylaw, remove the dedication of a highway that has been closed by a bylaw under subsection 40(1)(a);

NOW THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Langley, in Open Meeting Assembled, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "Highway Closing and Dedication Removal (Township Fort Block Lane) Bylaw 2020 No. 5634".
- 2. That portion of road lying in District Lot 19 Group 2 NWD shown outlined in heavy black line on the reference plan EPP100098 attached hereto as Schedule "A", prepared by M. Adam Fulkerson, BCLS, completed on the 29<sup>th</sup> day of January, 2020, and more particularly described as:

all that portion of Parcel A containing 252.4 square meters and dedicated on Plan 8856

shall be closed to traffic (hereinafter the "Lane").

- 3. The dedication as highway shall be removed from the Lane.
- 4. The Township Clerk is hereby authorized to sign the plan(s) of survey and any such other instrument(s) as may be required to carry into effect the closure and dedication removal described in this bylaw.
