

**THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LANGLEY**

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

Bylaw 2020 No. 5620 authorizes the Township of Langley to borrow \$4.392 million towards the estimated cost of the LED Street Light Program: Multiple Locations Project.

WHEREAS it is deemed desirable and expedient to construct LED Street Light Program: Multiple Locations capital works servicing the Township of Langley.

AND WHEREAS the *Community Charter*, Section 179 authorizes local governments to borrow money for any purpose of a capital nature.

AND WHEREAS the estimated cost of the LED Street Light Program: Multiple Locations project including incidentals thereto is equal to the sum of \$4.392 million (Four million three hundred ninety-two thousand four hundred and twenty-four dollars) which is the amount of debt created by this bylaw.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Langley, in Open Meeting Assembled, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "LED Street Lighting Conversion Loan Authorization Bylaw 2020 No. 5620".
2. The Council is hereby empowered and authorized to undertake and carry out or cause to be carried out the construction of the LED Street Light Program: Multiple Locations project generally in accordance with general plans on file in the municipal office and to do all things necessary in connection therewith and without limiting the generality of the foregoing:
  - a. To borrow upon the credit of the Municipality a sum not exceeding \$4,392,424 (Four million three hundred ninety-two thousand four hundred and twenty-four dollars).
  - b. To acquire all such real property, easements, rights-of-way, licenses, rights or authorities as may be requisite or desirable for or in connection with construction of the said LED Street Light Program: Multiple Locations project.
3. The maximum term for which debentures may be issued to secure the debt created by this bylaw is 20 years.
