We thank you for your consideration.

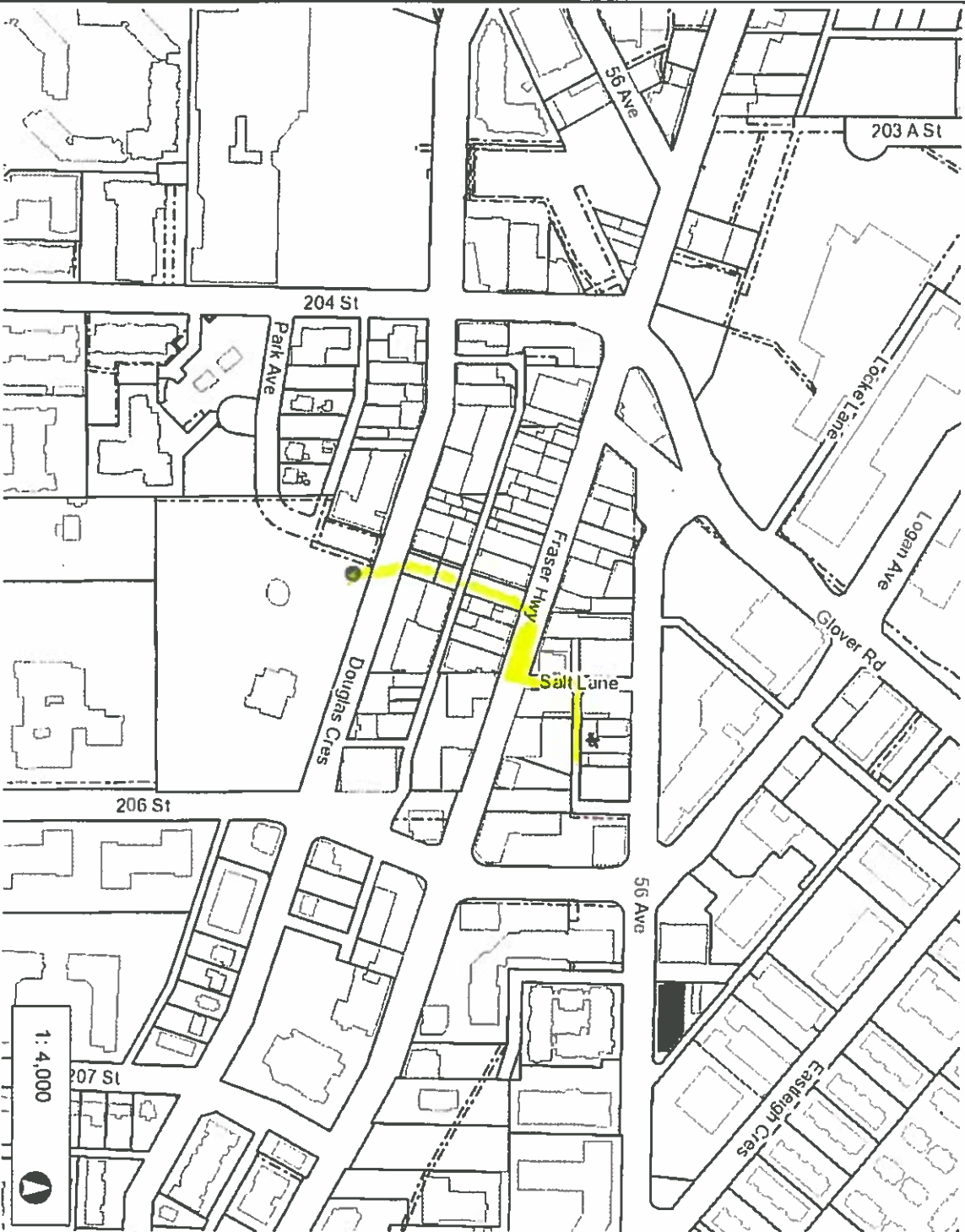
