D. PRESENTATIONS

D.1 Integrated Storm Water Management Plan

M. Lee provided a presentation regarding and Integrated Stormwater Management Plan (ISMP) for the West Creek Watershed Area. She noted that an ISMP is a guiding document identifying goals and targets on a watershed based level, and a comprehensive, ecosystem based approach for stormwater management. The Township of Langley is required by the Ministry of Environment to undertake ISMPs for watersheds designated for greater than 20% development. West Creek Watershed area has less than 20% designated for development and therefore does not meet the threshold to require an ISMP. The Township can voluntarily undertake an ISMP for any watershed regardless of the 20% requirement, however an ISMP requires significant resources and staff time. The developable area within the West Creek Watershed is close to being fully developed. An ISMP would be most effective in influencing future re-development of this area.
