That Council send a letter to Premier John Horgan, the Minister of Municipal Affairs, the Minister of Environment and Climate Change Strategy, and all local Members of Legislative Assembly requesting immediate consideration for the development of an alternative to the Climate Action Revenue Incentive Program that provides consistent and comparable annual funding for local governments to deliver climate action projects; and further

That Council endorse submission of a resolution to the Union of

BC Municipalities (UBCM) for consideration at the upcoming Convention to be held in September 2021 requesting that the Provincial Government immediately develop an alternative to the Climate Action Revenue Incentive Program as a source of sustainable funding for municipalities to undertake critical climate action projects, as outlined in more detail in the body of this report.
